The adornment of the sanctuary with plants, flowers and other gifts from God's creation is a marvelous way of enhancing our corporate worship, and is also a way for us to remember loved ones and to give thanks to God for people or events in our lives. You may sign up to donate these decorations by filling out the information below. There can be more than one donor for any date, as we wish to provide as much opportunity as possible for people to remember those people and events that are important to them.

The suggested donation is \$70 which should be received at the church before the date you have reserved. The Flower Guild will determine the type of decoration that is appropriate for both the time of the calendar year and for the liturgical season.

At St. David's we traditionally do not have decorations in the church during Lent, and we use greens to decorate during Advent. We recognize, however, that there are memorials or thanksgivings that people may wish to offer that occur during those seasons.
